# Covid security policy for visitors

Jane and Paul Tomlinson will be exhibiting their paintings for Artweeks in the garden gallery at 7 Pigeon House Lane. The garden gallery is a large, light and airy conservatory space, accessible through the garden. For everyone's safety, visitors must comply with these measures.

### Arrival and registration

Every visitor should register their attendance for **track and trace** using the gov.uk **NHS covid app**. Use your smartphone to scan the prominently displayed QR code on arrival. If you don't have a smartphone, your name, phone number and date of visit will be recorded. This information will be kept for 21 days after which it will be destroyed and not used for any other purpose.

- **Hand sanitiser** will be available and all visitors are required to use it on arrival. If you have plastic gloves please bring them and wear them.
- Masks, full-face visors or **face coverings must be worn** by all visitors and exhibitors.
- **Social distancing** at 2 metres must be maintained between groups wherever possible.
- Doors and windows will be left open to allow maximum **ventilation**. An outdoor area with seating is available.
- **Entry & exit** Visitors may enter by the front door of the garden gallery and exit via the back.
- **Waiting:** Visitors may wait to enter the garden gallery in the garden (it's large and lovely!) or on the patio where there is seating and a gazebo in the event of a shower.
- **Cleaning** will take place every day, with high touch surfaces sprayed and wiped frequently.
- **Visitors** may enter individually, in pairs, or as a household group. **No more than 4 visitors** at any time may enter the garden gallery.
- Before viewing **high touch hazards**, such as greetings cards and items in browsers, please re-sanitise your hands. Try to look with your eyes, and not with your hands!

### Exhibition catalogue

An exhibition catalogue will be available as a laminated sheet which should be handed back after use for spraying with sanitiser after each use.

### Comfort

- We invite visitors to bring their own drinks in a flask and cup to enjoy seated outside in the garden, safely socially distanced.
- An outdoor area with seating is available to visitors.
- Sorry! We can't offer toilet facilities as we are not able clean them after each visit and so keep them covid safe.

### Payment

Cash will be accepted but please re-sanitise your hands before handling it. Visitors are asked to pay for items via contactless payments wherever possible - a card payment reader is available, and we also accept PayPal & bank transfers.
